

Helsinki Backup Power Storage Project

Is this Finland's largest battery energy storage system?

Swedish flexible assets developer and optimizer Ingrid Capacity has joined hands with SEB Nordic Energy's portfolio company Locus Energy to develop what is claimed to be Finland's largest and one of the Nordics' largest battery energy storage systems (BESS). The 70 MW/140 MWh BESS project will be located in Nivala, northern Finland.

Will electricity be the backbone of Finland's energy system by 2050?

"By 2050, electricity will be the backbone of the entire energy system," said Matti Vaattovaara, Country Managing Director of Hitachi ABB Power Grids' business in Finland. He continued, "Together with TVO, we are enabling the people of Finland to move towards a carbon-neutral future."

When will the energy grid project start in Finland?
