

# Inverter connected to potentiometer maximum power

How do you connect a potentiometer to an inverter?

The most important connection at the Potentiometer end is the centre terminal or "wiper". The wiper will output a variable voltage between 0 and 10 Volts and should be connected to the "AI1" terminal on the Inverter. It is this voltage which provides the speed signal with 0V being slowest and 10V fastest.

How do I change the output frequency of a 10V potentiometer?

To change this, edit Parameter F112. The default output frequency at 10V is 50Hz. To change this, edit Parameter F111. If the rotation of the Potentiometer is the opposite to that required (ie. turn anti-clockwise to increase speed instead of clockwise) reverse connections GND and 10V.

Can a digital potentiometer cause oscillation?

When the circuit input is an ac signal, the parasitic capacitances of the digital potentiometer can cause undesirable oscillation in the output. This can be avoided, however, by connecting a small capacitor, C1, between the inverter input and its output. A value of 10 pF was used for the gain and phase plots shown in Figure 3. Figure 3.

What is the maximum speed of the inverter?

Which potentiometer should I use for my AC10?

This provides the benefit of allowing motor speed to be controlled from a more convenient location such as a cabinet door (if the AC10 is cabinet-mounted) or on the machine itself. Any potentiometer rated from 2kOhm to 5kOhm can be used - eg. 4.7kOhm. The number of turns depends on the application.

The maximum output voltage does not exceed the power supply voltage. The maximum output voltage can be changed within the setting range. However, the maximum point of the voltage waveform at the inverter output side is the power supply voltage multiplied by about 1.1. The power supply capacity is the value at the rated output current.

This is the simplest possible configuration. The track is connected between the output voltage & ground and feedback taken from the wiper. Connect one end of the potentiometer (end 1) to the +10V (or +5V) power output of the inverter. Connect the other end of the potentiometer (end #3) to the GND (ground) terminal of the inverter. Connect the middle end (end #2) of the potentiometer to the analog input (AI) ...

With power removed from the inverter, the EL lamps(s) should be replaced by an adjustable resistor and adjustable capacitor connected in a parallel configuration. With power applied to the inverter, with the same dc input voltage as when it was powering the EL lamp, the resistance and capacitance should be adjusted to produce exactly

For example, if a potentiometer is rated at 2 k $\Omega$  (kilohms), it means that the resistance across its track is

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equivalent to a fixed resistor with a value of 2 k $\Omega$ . Rated Power: the maximum power rating indicates the amount of power a potentiometer can handle to prevent overheating or failure.
