



Solar System Export

What is solar export limiting?

Export limiting usually refers to a cap set by the grid on how much surplus solar energy your system can export back to the grid. This infers that during periods where the solar panels are producing excess energy that the household isn't currently using, there might be a limit to what can be sent back to the grid for credit.

What is solar export control?

In essence, solar export control refers to the amount of solar power you can send to the grid from a grid-connected solar installation. These limits can apply to any size of solar installation, from utility-scale projects to solar panels on private residences. Suppose a solar plant produces more electricity than can be supplied to the grid.

Can a solar system export power to the grid?

With this method, a solar installation is not permitted to export any power to the grid. While this prevents problems with the grid, it is often the case that excess energy generated by a system is wasted unless storage solutions are in place. How does a solar export limiter work?

Can a solar inverter be exported?

Larger inverters are normally only permitted if they are zero export limited. When a home is export limited, all the power the solar inverter can produce is available for the home to use.

Is exporting surplus solar power a good idea?

Exporting surplus solar power is good because it reduces fossil fuel generation and pays you a feed-in tariff that reduces electricity bills. It's becoming common for solar inverters to be export limited, so the maximum amount of power they send into the grid is less than they're capable of providing. This is done for three main reasons:

Can a home export a lot of solar power?

The Bad: Most homes can't export as much power as in Good locations, but export limiting can be used to install larger solar systems. And The Ugly: Here, most homes are limited to 5 kilowatts of solar inverter capacity or less, and export limiting is usually not permitted. The information below assumes the property is on the main grid.

Solar export limiting in Queensland sets a cap on the amount of energy a solar system can export into the grid, usually around 5KW. The limit is in place to prevent power surges and issues caused by excessive energy sent to the grid, and to protect the grid from power shortages.

In a solar system, the inverter can convert the DC power to AC power, which supplies the load first and the excess will be injected into the grid. However, due to the need to maintain grid quality, not all countries or electricity companies can allow generators to export to the grid, so the need to control zero output has arisen.

The ZERO EXPORT controller measures in real time the power flowing in the system and adjusts the set point of the solar system accordingly. The 5kW export limit wasn't really an issue when the average solar system size was 6.6kW, which really wasn't all that long ago. But systems today are bigger - 10kW and even larger is common. There's a better way - and that's flexible exports done right.

Solar export limiting is where your local electricity provider sets a limit on the amount of energy your solar system can export into the grid. Typically, this is around 5KW. You have a set limit on how much energy you can export ("sell/send back") to the grid.

Note that not all customers will be able to export at 10 kW for the majority of the time.
